

Rules and regulations for the use of Plac Grunwaldzki OD NOWA space

Hello, hello and welcome to Plac Grunwaldzki OD NOWA, a neighbourhood space on the Plac Grunwaldzki district. We're very glad you're with us!

As part of the Plac Grunwaldzki OD NOWA initiative, we're implementing the following projects: Local Activity Centre [Centrum Aktywności Lokalnej], Children and Youth Growth and Activity Centre [Centrum Rozwoju i Aktywności Dzieci i Młodzieży] and a number of other activities in the areas of animation, education, prevention, local identity, culture and the arts. Here you'll take part in cultural and integration activities, organize your initiative, join in volunteering and, above all, have a good time!

In order for each person to feel comfortable here, we all follow the guidelines below. By entering this space and participating in the planned activities, you agree to abide by the rules of the place.

§ 1. WE ARE FOR EVERYONE

1. We welcome all residents of Plac Grunwaldzki, regardless of age, gender, background, economic status, fitness level or orientation. Everyone is welcome!
2. If you don't live in Grunwald and you like what we do, let us know. We're open and enjoy meeting new people, and we're most happy that our community is growing!
3. We're committed to making each person feel at home here. We do not accept expressions of aggression. Persons behaving in a discriminatory and/or exclusionary manner - verbally or non-verbally - towards others, may be asked to leave the Centre by the Foundation team.

§ 2. WE ALL CARE ABOUT THE SPACE

1. We like to share, which is why we put the Centre at your disposal! Feel free to brew a cup of tea or coffee, enjoy a pastry - treat yourself. If you are looking for a space to read a book, feel free to relax with a selected item from our mini library.
2. We all take care to keep our rooms tidy. After drinking your coffee, you should wash your cup and put it in its place. This rule applies to both the Foundation team and visitors.
3. We value the equipment, plants and other facilities at the Centre. We want all equipment to last as long as possible, so we ask you to be careful when using it.

4. If you notice that an item is broken, let the animators know. The person who caused the damage is responsible for the damage.

§ 3. SAFETY

1. Every person is expected to feel safe here. This applies to the team as well as to you, our neighbours.
2. It is strictly forbidden to consume alcohol and/or psychoactive substances at the Centre or to participate in activities while under their influence.
3. Consumption of tobacco products and e-cigarettes is prohibited on the Centre's territory.
4. We do not tolerate violence - verbal or non-verbal. Individuals displaying behavior that affects the safety of others may be asked to leave by the Foundation team.
5. The first-aid kit is located in the corridor, next to the main entrance. If medical assistance is needed, notify the Centre's animators.
6. Observe safety and fire protection regulations while on the Centre's territory.

§ 4. PARTICIPATION IN ACTIVITIES

1. The current offer of activities at the Centre can be found at www.placgrunwaldzki.com and on social media channels. If you want to find out what you can currently take part in, just ask the animators about the current offer.
2. There are different ways to sign up for events at the Centre, in most cases we do so in advance and announce them in our social media channels. It may happen that there is an event taking place at the Centre during your visit for which we may have run out of places beforehand. Animator will let you know if you can attend.
3. During events at the Centre, we may occasionally take photographs of the events - we ask permission from those attending each time - or ask those attending to sign an attendance list.
4. If you have special needs and require the presence of an assistant, please let us know in advance. We will do everything in our power to ensure that you get the right support during all the activities!

§ 5. CHILDREN

2. Children and Youth Growth and Activity Centre that we run in our space has its own rules and regulations that apply to those using this programme - children and parents/carers.
3. Following a policy of protecting children and young people from harm, we treat children with respect, care and empathy, ensuring their physical and emotional safety. We tackle all forms of abuse, neglect and exploitation by responding immediately to suspicions or reports of wrongdoing. We provide children with an environment where they feel protected, supported and free from danger.
